2 chords. On 2nd chord 1 W crosses down to R of $\mathrm{P}, 2 \mathrm{~W}$ moves 1 place up and 2 M crosses to her place, so 1c faces 2c.

1c+2c R\&L, finish with 2M between 2W \& 1 W facing down and $\mathrm{NHJ}, 1 \mathrm{M}$
 behind him
9- $\quad 1 \mathrm{~W}+2 \mathrm{M}+2 \mathrm{~W}$ dance down the middle, 1 M following ; all turn (W inwards, M R about) 1 M NHJ with the women, and 2M following, dance up to finish in line across, the W on the sidelines facing $P$ in the middle ( 1 c on M side)
17- $\quad 1 \mathrm{c}+2 \mathrm{c}$ set to P : Glasgow Highlanders step (M may do some other Highland step)
25- Reels4 $\{6\}$ across the dance $\mid 1 \mathrm{c}$ lead down the $M$ side and 2 c up the $W$ side to face next couple. On reaching the top, 2 c waits inactive on own side ; on reaching the bottom 1c waits inactive on own side.

Notes: The RSCDS prescribes a 4c set, but the tradition is a longwise set 'for as many as will'.

$1 \mathrm{M}+2 \mathrm{M}+3 \mathrm{M}$ clap while $1 \mathrm{~W}+2 \mathrm{~W}+3 \mathrm{~W}$ turn around their partner (passing Rsh), twirl in front of them and go back to their place. All set.
9- $\quad$ 2c does the "figure of love" (= two inverted hearts): 2W crosses up and casts down 1 place, while 2 M crosses down and casts up 1 place. 2c meet in the middle, touch both hands and twirl (Lsh back). 2W casts off (behind 3M) and crosses back to original place, while 2 M casts off (behind 1W) and crosses back to place.


17- 1c set advancing (passing Rsh), then turn BH (about $3 / 4$ turn), at the end of the turn, 1W passes under 1M's arm. 1W casts off 1 place behind 2 M while 1 M casts off 1 place behind 2 W (2c steps up) : 1c meet in second place, in the middle of the set, turn without hands (passing Lsh) and swivel left to face 1st cnrs.
